


















# Information for the practical separation of waste

Waste type	What does it include?	Preparation	Place of disposal	Comments
<b>Household rubbish</b>	 Milk and fruit juice packets, plastic, soiled cardboard, detergent drums, flower paper, labels and other self-adhesive labels, aluminium packaging etc.	place in tied up, official waste bags, subject to a disposal fee	at official container shelters or private waste collection points	do not place rubbish bags alongside the waste collection point
<b>Waste glass</b>	 Glass, disposable bottles, glasses	place in the special containers; do not place alongside	in the specially labelled containers at public containers shelters or private waste collection points	no window glass, no porcelain
<b>Paper</b>	 Newspapers, newspaper supplements, brochures, pamphlets, writing paper, catalogues, photocopies, telephone books, notepaper, books etc.	place in the special containers; do not place alongside	brings! collection point in Spiss, mobile brings! or specially labelled collection points according to waste collection calendar	paper must not be disposed of in plastic bags or boxes. Commercial firms will transport the waste directly to the brings! collection point in Spiss
<b>Cardboard</b>	 Corrugated cardboard and any other cardboard without plastic adhesive strips	place in the special containers; do not place alongside	brings! collection point in Spiss, mobile brings! or specially labelled collection points according to waste collection calendar	the cardboard must be folded together before disposal. Commercial firms will transport the waste directly to the brings! collection point in Spiss
<b>Bulky goods</b>	 Flammable and non-recyclable bulky items, skis, furniture, mattresses, bathroom fixtures	position in an orderly manner on collection days - bind together loose items or according to directions for community	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	no electronic devices or fridges
<b>Bio-organic waste</b>	 Raw organic waste, food remains, egg shells, coffee grounds and fruit peel	in containers which are available separately	according to a special collection cycle, following consultation with the contractor	only for catering businesses
<b>Green waste</b>	 Grass cuttings, leaves, branches, shrubs, weeds, garden plant waste, cut flowers and pot plants (without pot)	dispose of in the special containers	in the specially labelled containers at public containers shelters or private waste collection points	no food waste
<b>Tin, steel and aluminium cans and aluminium</b>	 Aluminium, cans, lids from jam jars and other food jars, pet food trays, spray cans without the orange danger symbol, foil and other aluminium pieces	rinse out cans and remove labels	in the specially labelled containers at public containers shelters	Aluminium and tin are separated by the disposal contractor
<b>Oils and fats</b>	 Oils and fats of animal and plant origin and mineral oil (engine and gearbox oil)	collect separately	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	Commercial firms will transport the waste directly to the brings! collection point in Spiss
<b>Textiles and shoes</b>	 Clothes and shoes which are still wearable, curtains, table and bed linen, duvets, cushions, belts, bags	washed and placed in bags sent out by charity or collection organisations in the post	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	clean goods in tied bags. Tie shoes together in pairs.
<b>Old iron and metals</b>	 All kinds of metal (racks, clothes horses, bike frames, pans etc.)	collect separately	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	no electronic devices
<b>Electronic waste</b>	 Laptops, printers, telephones, mobiles, accessories such as toners and CDs, TVs, radios, PlayStations, drilling machines, washing machines, cookers, fridges, freezer cabinets, air-conditioning devices, boilers	Back to point of sale or collection point	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	when purchasing new items, this includes financing of the anticipated recycling fees, so you can take items back to the point of sale for free
<b>Batteries</b>	 Batteries and coin batteries from radios, cameras, watches, toys etc.	Back to point of sale or collection point	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	old batteries should be taken back to the point of sale
<b>PET bottles</b>	 Bottles with the PET symbol	Back to point of sale or collection point	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	Plastics without a PET symbol should be disposed of in rubbish bags. PET bottles should be placed in the relevant labelled containers.
<b>Special waste</b>	 Dyes, paints, solvents, chemicals, pesticides, medication, mercury thermometers, spray cans with the orange safety symbol	Back to point of sale or collection point	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	in sealed containers and if possible in original packaging with label
<b>Energy-saving bulbs and neon tubes</b>	 Fluorescent bulbs, fluorescent tubes, fluorescent lamps, energy-saving lamps, mercury/ sodium vapour lamps	Back to point of sale or collection point	brings! collection point in Spiss or mobile brings! according to waste collection calendar	no electric bulbs and halogen lamps – these can be disposed of with the household waste
<b>Animal carcasses, slaughterhouse waste</b>	 Dead or stillborn pets of to 200 kg, dead game, fish, slaughterhouse waste, dead animals, entrails, bones, fat, skin, hair, feathers etc.		at the slaughterhouse or collection points allocated by the community	Book in advance with the responsible person: (✉) <a href="mailto:schlachthaus@zermatt.ch">schlachthaus@zermatt.ch</a>
